HTML PAGES AT WEB SERVERS, WEBSITES, AND WEB APPLICATIONS

- Mobile devices are available with different screen sizes, usually bigger than before
- Hand-held devices support Internet connectivity
- Direct access to websites, webpages and web applications

HTML

- Hypertext Mark-up Language (HTML) is basic a programming and a globally accepted markup language.
- Most popular language of browsers and Web pages.
- HTML for web applications built using markup, scripting languages, and cascade style sheets (CSS)

WEB PAGE

- The document with HTML encoding as it appears on a browser is called *Web page*
- at a server

HTML

- Hypertext means a text on an HTML document that enables jump to another document on click
- The jump process is called *navigation*.
- Website– a collection of Web pages

- HTML embeds scripts (e.g., JavaScript) for processing on the application at a computing system
- Browser is an application for displaying HTML file text, images, animations, and multimedia and HTML forms.
- HTML specifies the styles and CSS
