

ORDINANCE NO. 161

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR TWO YEAR (INTEGRATED) MLISC/ONE YEAR BLISC/ONE YEAR MLICS PROGRAMME

01. Duration of the course:-

The master of library and information science shall comprise of a course of study spread over period of four semesters and two years duration. The candidate's will be regular/full time students of the course.

02. Eligibility :-

The eligibility for admission shall be as follows:

- I. A candidate seeking admission to the program must have passed a bachelor's degree examination in second division in any discipline of DAVV Indore or any other statutory university/Institute recognized as equivalent there to by vishwavidyalaya.
- II. The candidate must have attained the age at the time of admission as prescribed by the university from time to time.

03. Admission Procedure:-

The admission to the course conducted by UTD shall be through written/oral entrance examination as prescribed/decided by the university from time to time.

04. Number of Seats:-

05.

The total numbers of seats are 30. Five seats are reserved for working librarians. The Reservation of seats shall be as per M.P. Government/University rules. If any seats are vacant in the second year, the BLISC degree holders will be eligible for the same through an entrance test.

06. Option:-

The students can either take admission for one year BLISC Course (52 Credits)/ one year MLISC (54 Credits) Courses or for two year integrated MLISC course (106 Credits). Every year the admission will be held for the remaining seats for MLISC.

07. Fees Structure:-

I. The fee structure for the course is under self-financing. The students have to pay Rs. 6000.00 fees for semester. However the fees structure is subject to change by the Executive council from time to time.

II. Students are required to pay, enrollment fee. University development fee in addition to above.

08. Curriculum:-

I. The details of the subjects to be taught during the two years period under four semesters, curriculum pattern and examination scheme for each semester shall be subject to the approval of the concerned board of studies/faculty/other academic bodies for the university.

II. In addition to this, students will be required to under take and complete assignments, seminars etc. as prescribed in the course of study.

III. The detailed courses of study, credits and syllabus is enclosed in Annexure.

09. Eligibility for the Degree.

The candidate shall be eligible for the degree when he/she has under gone the prescribed course of studies for a period of not less than one and half years in the institution and has passed the required examination in all the subjects.

10. Requirement for the examination and attendance:-

The candidate will be permitted to appear in examination if he/she has put in minimum attendance of the lectures each subject as prescribed under the rules as applicable from time to time and if he/she fulfils all other eligible conditions for appearing in examination.

11. Examination:-

I. Examination shall be conducted by the university as per the provision of Ordinance No. 31.

II. The general Provisions of examination under the ordinance 5 & 6 and admission enrollment etc. shall be applicable unless otherwise specified in this Ordinance.

III. For matters not covered in this ordinance, General rules of the university examination shall be applicable. In other cases the Executive Council shall be the competent authority to decide.

Note:- As per decision of the executive council meeting dated 20th April, 2005 the course can be conducted by the university teaching department only.

Ordinance No. - 162

1. Degree Title: **M.Sc. Physics (Materials Science)**
2. Name of Faculty: Faculty of Science
3. Duration of Course: Full time 2 years, 4 Semesters.
4. Eligibility: B.Sc. [50 % marks with Physics and Mathematics as subject from Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya or any other University recognized by U.G.C.]
5. Admission Procedure: Decided by Admission Committee of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya and Subject to revision from time to time.
6. Total Seats: As per statute 27 of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya.
7. Fee Structure: Decided by Admission Committee of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya and subject to revision from time to time.
8. Examination Curriculum And related Regulations: As per Ordinance 31 of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya Indore.
9. Eligibility for Degree: A candidate shall be eligible for the award of M.Sc. Physics (Materials Science) degree provided he/she has successfully completed the requirement of examination as per Ordinance 31 of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya.
10. Attendance requirement: A candidate must have at least 75 % attendance in both theory lessons and laboratory works separately. Under exceptional situations it may be relaxed admissible within applicable ordinances.
11. General instruction and Provisions: For matters not covered in this specific ordinance general rules and regulation of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya regarding semester/annual examination are applicable. In other matters EXECUTIVE COUNCIL of Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya shall be competent to take any decision.

Ordinance No.- 163

B.P.Ed (Bachelor of Physical Education) One Year Course

Introduction:

The Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P. Ed) is meant for preparing teacher in Physical Education. The aim of this course is to prepare professional leaders of Physical Education who will serve the nation by their professional knowledge and skill.

Name of the course:

B.P. Ed. (Bachelor of Physical Education) One Year Course.

Duration of the course: One Academic Year

Eligibility :

- a. Age-As per University and state Govt. Rules.
- b. *Graduate (three year degree course in any subject) and having represented state/University in any games or sports.
*Graduate in Physical Education i.e. B.P.E. of three year duration.
*Graduate (three-year degree course in any subject) and having N.C.C. "C" Certificate or passed basic course in adventure sports.
- c. Reservation-As per University and state Govt. rules.

Admission Procedure:

Admission will be made on merit and it will be based on written and practical test.

Note:

- The College/Department has the right to include or delete any game according to the administrative feasibility.
- the candidate have to secure at least 40% Marks in the sports field otherwise in spite of his fulfilling all the (remaining or) else requirement he/she will not be able to get admission.

Eligible Candidates:

On the basis of performance in the admission test the list of unreserved and reserved categories will be displayed on the notice board of the department. In every category the admission will be given only on the basis of merit. If any seats are found vacant in any category it will be filled on the basis of merit from the waiting list of that category. If the seats are still vacant it will be field from unreserved category.

Note :-

- The seats for SC and ST are interchangeable.
- The change in the rules of the state Govt./University will be applicable from the time to time.

Attendance: -

A candidate shall be required 85% of attendance in theory and practical separately to appear in final examination.

- i. The final examination shall be held at the end of session or the dates announced by the University. After fulfilling the required working days norms i.e. 180 working days.
- ii. A candidate will have to pass separately in part A (Theory) and Part B (Practical) examination.
- iii. In theory examination a candidate must secure at least 40% marks in each theory paper in the final examination and should also secure minimum 45% marks in aggregate.
- iv. In practical examination a candidate must secure at least 45% marks in each activity in final examination and should also secure minimum 45% in aggregate.
- v. No pass percentage is required for sessional examination for theory and practical.
- vi. In case a candidate fail in one or more paper in part (a) A (Theory) or part B (Practical) he will be require to pass the part/parts in which he/she has failed in the subsequent examination. He/she has option to appear in one or more paper in which he/she has failed or whole of the examination of that part/parts the next year as ex student
(b) The sessional marks obtained by the students will be carried forward for next year examination.
- vii. A candidate who fulfils all the requirements to appear in the final examination but has not been able to appear on medical grounds may be allowed by the vice-chancellor to appear in the same examination in the following year as ex student.
- viii. A woman candidate will automatically Looses the right to continue in the course if She is in family way.
- ix. A candidate will be required to Produce medical fitness certificate from Government doctor at the time of entrance test.

Note :- Specialisation Will be offered only in those games where facility and specialised staff of particular game is available.

Percentage of Passing:-

- Third Division - 33% & above but below 45% of the aggregate.
- Second Division - 45% & above but below 60% of the aggregate.
- First Division - 60% & above of the aggregate.

XI. In case a candidate fails to achieve the aggregate of 45% in theory then he/she will have an option to appear in not more than two papers in which he has obtained minimum marks to make up the aggregate in the supplementary examination.

XII. If a candidate fails to secure total aggregate of 45% in practicals then he/she will have an option to appear in one practical examinations in which he/she has obtained minimum marks.

Ordinance for 2 years M.Sc. (Microbiology) course

Ordinance No. 164

1. Degree Title: **M.Sc. (Microbiology) 2 years**
2. Name of the Faculty : Life Sciences
3. Duration of the Course: The Master of Science in Microbiology shall comprise a regular course of study spread over a period of 2 years. The candidates shall be regular and full time students of the course.
4. Eligibility : The eligibility of admission shall be as follows:
 - (i) A candidate seeking admission to the M.Sc. (Microbiology) course must have passed B.Sc. (Hons) in Microbiology in first division or B.Sc. in first division with any three subjects (Microbiology/ Industrial microbiology/Biotechnology/ Chemistry/Life Science/ Botany/ Zoology/Biochemistry/ Pharmaceutical chemistry/ Bioinformatics/ Computer Science) from Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore or any other Statutory University/Institute recognized as equivalent thereto by UGC.
 - (ii) The candidate should not have attained age higher than that prescribed at the time of admission as notified by the university from time to time.
5. Admission Procedure: The admission to the course shall be strictly on the basis of merit of theory marks obtained in graduation (B.Sc. Part I, II and III). Besides the following weightage shall be given during the admission:
 - (i) Ten percent weightage to applicants who opted microbiology/industrial microbiology as one of the subjects for graduation.

- Requirements for the examination and attendance:
- (ii) Five percent weightage to applicants who have graduated from Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya, Indore.
 - (iii) Five percent weightage to applicants who are residents of the State of Madhya Pradesh.

6. Number of seats : The total number of seats at each centre shall not exceed 20. The reservation of seats shall be as per M.P. Government/University rules.

7. Fees Structure:
- (i) The fees structure applicable to Self Financing Programmes shall also be applicable to the M.Sc. (Microbiology) course.
 - (ii) Students are also required to pay enrollment fee, university examination fee, university development fee, library and computer fee in addition on the tuition fee.

8. Curriculum:
- (i) The details of the subjects to be taught during the two years period, curriculum pattern and scheme of examination shall be subject to the approval of the concerned board of studies/ other academic bodies of the university.
 - (ii) In addition, the students will be required to undertake and complete assignments, seminars etc. as prescribed by the Centre running the course.
 - (iii) The detailed Courses of Studies, credits and syllabus are enclosed in the Annexure.

9. Eligibility for the Degree: The candidate shall be eligible for M.Sc. (Microbiology) degree when he/ she has undergone the prescribed courses of studies for a period of not less than two years in the institution and has passed the requisite examination in all subjects.

10. Requirements for the examination and attendance:

The candidate will be permitted to appear in the examination if he/she has put in minimum attendance of the lectures on each subject and practical as prescribed under the rules as applicable from time to time and if he/she fulfils all other eligibility conditions for appearing in the examination.

11. Examination :

(i) Examination shall be conducted by the university as per the provisions of Ordinance No. 6.

(ii) The general provisions of examination under the ordinances 5 and 6 and admission enrollment, etc. shall be applicable unless otherwise specified in this Ordinance.

- (1) Name of Course : M.Tech. in Spatial Information Technology
(2) Name of Faculty : Faculty of Engineering Sciences
(3) **Duration:**

Master of Technology (M.Tech.) in Spatial Information Technology shall comprise the course of study spread over period two years (four semesters) and will be a full time regular students programme.

(4) **Eligibility:**

(1) A candidate seeking admission to the course should have passed with 55% B.E. or B.Tech. Electronics & Communication, Electronics & Instrumentation, Computer Science Engineering, Information Technology civil, M.Sc. Electronics, Computer Science, Information Technology Geology, Remote Sensing or MCA.

(2) The candidate must be qualified in GATE in the relevant discipline

(5) **Admission Process:**

For M.E./M.Tech. admission will be made by a committee approved by Vice-Chancellor. The admission to the programme will be conducted by U.T.D. (School of Electronics) shall be through the merit on the All India GATE examination or any other merit criteria approved by the Committee.

(6) **Total Seats:**

The total number of seats shall not exceed twenty five. Reservation of seats shall be as per University rules.

(7) **Fee Structure :**
