11. REQUIREMENTS FOR EXAMINATIONS AND ATTENDANCE

Four examinations will be conducted by the University at the end of each Semester with a minimum passing mark of 50%.

Examination will be theory and practical. A candidate will be permitted to appear for the University examination in the subject only if:

- 11.1 He secures not less than 75% attendance in Theory and Practical in each subject.
- 11.2 His conduct is satisfactory.
- 11.3 The student will be allowed to carry not more than 2 subjects at a time in the duration of the whole course.

12. **THESES**

The topic for the thesis should be selected in the first Semester of the 2nd year. The student shall submit the thesis at least a month before the due date for the final university examination. The remaining 60% of the marks are for the Semester-End Examinations.

(b) 50% of the marks in the Practical Examination wherever prescribed shall be declared to have passed the examination in the subject.

A candidate who completes the course of study and passes in that subject with:

(Pharmaceutical Chemistry)s Faculty of Science Full time, 2Years (4 Semester) A candidate should have at least 55% (45% for SC/ST/OBC Candidate) aggregate marks at Bache level degree under 10+2+3 pattern with Chemistr one of the subjects from Devi Ahilya Vishwavidya Indore or any other recognized institute/Unive recognized as equivalent there to by UGC.
(5)	Admission Procedure:	Admission to the course shall be strictly on the basis of merit of thery marks obtained in gradut (B.Sc. I,II and III) or as decided by the university State Government rules.
(6)	Total Seats :	Total numbers of seats shall not. Exceed 20 The reservation of seats shall be as per M.P. Government rules.
(7)	Fees Structure :	 (i) The fees at present is Rs. 9000/- per year. The fees shall change as per the D.A.V.V. from time to time. (ii) Students are also required to pay enrolment fee. University examination fee, university development fee, library and computer fee in addition the tuition fee and other fees as per the rule.
