#### M.Sc. in Fisheries Science

(1) Degree Title

M.Sc.(Fisheries Science)

(2) Name of faculty

Faculty of Science

(3) <u>Duration of Course</u>:

Full time, Two Years(Four Semester)

(4) Eligibility: A candidate should have B.Sc. degree under10+2+3 pattern with Bio and Fish as subjects from Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalay Indore or any other recognized university/ Institute recognized as equivalent there to by U.G.C. with at least 55% aggregate marks (for SC/ST/OBC and others as proposed by state Govt. Univ. Candidate) at Bachelor level degree.

- (5) Admission Procedure: Admission of eligible candidate to the course shall be strictly on the basis of merit of marks obtained in graduate (B.Sc. I,II and III ) or as decided by the University /state Govt. rules/ Autonomous Institute/ College of Excellence.
- (6) <u>Total Seats</u>: Total numbers of seats shall not be exceed 20.The reservation of seats shall be as per M.P. Govt. rules.
- (7) Fee Structure : (i) The fee Structure as present will be 7000 per year. The fee shall be changed as per D.A.V.V. rules and regulation from time to time or shall be decided by the concerning college / Autonomous Institute.

(ii) Students are also required to pay enrollment fee. University examination fee University Development fee library and computer fee in addition the tuition fee and other fee as per the rule.

- 4.Name of faculty- Faculty of Medicine (Nursing)e as approved by Indian Nursing Council and the State Nursing Council. No age limit is there. The selection of the candidates will be made by the Selection Committee/Board of the concerned college or according to the Norms of particular college by authentic authority & married candidates are eligible for admission
- 5.Admission procedure- Admission through prescribed application: No candidate shall be admitted unless she/he has applied to the institution on the prescribed form admitted through selection procedure and through administrative authorities if in Govt. - 2. NOMENCLATURE OF THE DEGREE The course shall be called as "AYURVEDACHARYA" B.A.M.S. degree course. The degree shall be designed as "Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery" and abbreviated as "B.A.M.S. "Thus the designation of the degree shall be the same as awarded to the studends passing 4.1/2 years (three professionals each of having one and half year—duration i.e.18 months) degree course as regular students and after completion of one—year rotatory internsship. (As per the notification of C.C.I.M New delhi the 6th—oct.2010)
