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



Ordinance for BBA. LL.B. (Hons) & B.Com.LL.B. (Hons) Degree
Five years Course

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This ordinance shall be applicable in University teaching department as well as affiliated Colleges.

1. The Degree of Bachelor of Law (BBA. LL.B. (Hons) & B.Com. LL.B. (Hons) Shall comprise of a course of study spread over a period of five years and the candidates will be full time regular students. The five year course shall comprise two parts i.e. part - I, which will be a two year core programme of pre-law study and part-II which will be a three Year programme for professional training in law.
2. THE ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS;
 - (a) At the time of joining the course of instruction in law, the person concerned has to pass an examination in 10+2 course of schooling recognized by the educational authority of Central or State Government or posses academic qualification considered equivalent to 10+2 courses by the Bar Council of India.
 - (b) Lateral entry will be permitted in Third Year of the course to graduates of any discipline as prescribed by Bar Council of India after the entrance test depending on the availability of seats.
 - (c) The candidate must have completed the age of 17 Years at the time of admission. Maximum age for admission shall not be more than 22 years. (age of admission shall be subjected to approval of the concerned board of studies as per guidelines of B.C.I. in this regards.
3. The admission to the course shall be through an entrance examination/merit.
4. Details of subjects to be taught during the five years courses, curriculum pattern and examination scheme for each year course shall be subject to approval of the concerned Board of studies/Faculty as per the guidance of the Bar Council of India in this regard.



5. ELIGIBILITY FOR THE DEGREE :

- (a) A Candidate shall be eligible for the degree for Bachelor of Laws, BBA. LL.B. (Hons) / B.Com.LL.B (Hons) When he has undergone the prescribed course of study for a period of not less than five years in the Institution and has passed the requisite examination in all the subjects.
 - (b) The students successfully completing first three years of B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) will be awarded B.A.(Law) degree approval by the University. This degree will be equivalent to other graduation degree of the University. Such degree shall not entitle the student to enroll as an advocate.
6. The teaching shall start in July and January of every year and the Examinations there of shall be held twice a year ordinarily in the month of December and May.
7. A candidate will be permitted to appear for the examination only if he/she has put in a minimum attendance of 75% of the lectures on each of the subjects as also at the moot courts and practical training course.


8. PROMOTION RULES.

- (a) A candidate shall not be admitted in the fifth or higher semester classes unless he/she has fully cleared the first and second semester examinations.
 - (b) A candidate shall not be admitted in the seventh or higher semester classes unless he/she fully cleared the third and fourth semester examinations.
 - (c) A candidate shall not be admitted in the ninth or higher semester classes unless he/she fully cleared the fifth and sixth semester examinations.
9. No candidate shall be declared to have cleared the final BBA. LL.B. (Hons.) /B.Com LL.B. (Hons.) examination unless he/she has cleared the previous semesters. The results of the candidates who have cleared the tenth and final BBA. LL.B. (Hons)/B.Com. LL.B. (Hons.) Semester but



not the previous semester shall be withheld. He/she shall be deemed to have passed the final BBA, LL.B./B.Com, LL.B. (Hons.) Examinations in the year in which he/she fully clears all the previous semester examinations.

10. The examination of odd semester shall be held with the odd semester and the examination of even semester shall take place with the even semester.
11. A candidate who has been declared unsuccessful in an examination may at his/her option reappear at it subsequently, as an ex-student without being required to attend regular course of study again for the same semester subject to the condition that such a candidate shall abide by and be governed by the provisions of this and other ordinances applicable.
12. (a) In order to be successful at a semester examination a candidate must secure at least 40% of marks in each paper and also at least 50% of aggregate of grand total.
(b) In each theory paper the allocation of marks shall be 80% on external assessment and 20% on internal assessment. The internal assessment for each subject shall be based on activities scheduled by the Department such as presentation, group discussion etc. along with regular attendance in library and class lectures.
(c) The marks for internal assessment shall be finalized by the department/college.
13. Those securing 60% marks or more shall be placed in Ist division and other successful examinees securing less than 60% marks shall be placed in IInd division.
14. The award of grace marks shall be as per University rules, applicable on other professional courses.
15. The provisions of the ordinance in respect of requirement for examination attendance results and grades are subject to alteration from time to time and shall conform to guidelines and instruction of Bar council India and Department of Higher Education Govt. of M.P.
